



## Dear parents/guardians,

We hope everyone had a wonderful summer holiday. We are looking forward to another fantastic school year!

A lot of work was done during the holidays: the facades have finally been renovated and the fences are being removed. This means that we can once again use the second entrance to the left of the school playground. The entrance near the car park will **no** longer be used. The school door opens every day at 8:20 a.m. and closes again at 8:30 a.m. We expect all children to be in class by then, so that the school day can start on time.

Children in groups 1-2 and T Green only need gym shoes. These are kept in the classroom.
